- Provide adequate information, instruction, training, and supervision to enable all staff to do their work safely, avoid hazards, and contribute positively to their health and safety at work.
- Provide and maintain safe working areas, equipment, and systems and, where necessary, appropriate protective clothing.
- Identify substances and materials that are potentially hazardous to health and the overall health and safety of employees, and make sure arrangements are put in place to monitor and control the risks they pose.
- Comprehensively investigate accidents, incidents, and cases of work-related illness, so it can identify and correct any shortcomings in its Health and Safety management arrangements and processes.
- Work with the support of external agencies and within our industry, to ensure our continued adoption of best-practice solutions in health and safety management is appropriate.
- Make sure it continuously improves its Health and Safety performance and ensure that the necessary resources are available to help the business deliver those improvements.
- Review and revise this policy yearly and at regular intervals as required, making any necessary changes, and bringing those to the attention of all staff.
